

Are You a Good Fit?

If you are interested in affordable homeownership, you may be eligible through Habitat if you meet 3 criteria:



You will not be eligible if you: are a current homeowner; have \$1,000+ in collections; have any judgments or liens; have been in bankruptcy or foreclosure in the past 2 years; or are a registered sex offender.

Come to Your Keys and Learn More!

What to Expect:

Your Keys is both an orientation and a resource fair. It is the only time to apply for homeownership with Windy City Habitat in 2014.

- Sign-in for information sessions for up to 200 families will begin at 9:30am in front of the Kroc Center auditorium
- Sessions will be offered at 10:00 am, 11:00 am, 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm
- The first half of the session will introduce you to Habitat's homebuyer program
- You will then have the opportunity to review your personal finances with a financial counselor and tailor a plan for achieving homeownership and financial stability
- Regardless of fit or interest in Habitat, you are encouraged to explore the resource fair for job training, financial, housing and community opportunities
- The resource fair will be open to the public from 10 am – 2 pm

How to Prepare:

If you are interested in Habitat's Homebuyer Program:

- 1. Visit our website to learn more about qualifications at yourkeys.org.
- Review your credit report to make sure you don't have any disqualifying factors. For a free credit report, visit annualcreditreport.com or call (877) 322-8228
- Visit our build site in West Pullman to see if our homes and location appeal to you. Our current 16 home build is located on S. Union between 119th and 120th.
- 4. Pass on this information to a friend and/or relative

What to Bring:

- □ Driver's license or State ID
- \square 30 days of most recent paycheck stubs
- 2012 or 2013 tax return
- Supplemental income documentation (Child support order, SSI award letter, SNAP, etc.)
- □ Most recent savings account statement
